60/40%        5 to 8 shooters in class.  
50/30/20      9 or more shooters in class.

Shoot-off for all titles where necessary. Shoot-offs will be doubles at 3-4-5, total by station.

HOA: All money stay in class, Champ takes class money.

C of C, Options and class purse money stays in class. High score ties divide. H.O.A. and C. of C. classes will be determined by your (4) gun averages.

Concurrent Events – All individual concurrent events will be offered at no cost and will be honors only. If we forget to ask, please declare the concurrent you are eligible for at registration.

All WSSA AND NSSA target fees are included in the entry fees. 2017 NSSA rules apply
