



McChord JBLM Sportsmen's Club 2022 Ironman Invitational April 23 – 24, 2022

This year's **Ironman** will be **ONE** event consisting of 400 12 Gauge targets shot using **12 Gauge guns and 12 Gauge ammo only**. The program consists of 200 targets shot each day, 100 targets in AM and 2nd 100 targets in the PM. The program must be shot as advertised (200 targets/day). If you are unable to participate in the full program you may shoot targets only at \$30/100

Rotation 1: 9:00, 12:00 Rotation 2: 10:30, 1:30

To accommodate additional shooters, a 3rd rotation may be added; therefore, **PREREGISTRATION HIGHLY RECOMMENDED!!** * Management reserves the right to make necessary changes to the program. All such changes will be posted at registration.

Entry fee: \$160, including fees. \$20 of each entry will be returned to class. Payout will be 100% 1-4 in class, 5 or more in class will split 60-40, 9 or more will split 50/30/20. \$10 of each entry will go to champion. All ties will be decided by Doubles at 3-4-5 total by station. Checks will be mailed. Honorary concurrents.

General Information:

- 1) Club will open at 8:00 AM
- 2) Current NSSA rules apply. All shoot offs will be doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5.
- 3) Shoot management reserves the right to modify the program as necessary.
- 4) **Please have your current, updated 2022 NSSA classification card.** This is available at nssa-nasca.org/member-login.
- 5) Canteberry Voice Call system will be used. Shooters may be asked to keep score.
- 6) Due to nationwide shortage, shooters must provide their own ammunition to include proof shells. **PLEASE use #9 shot for all events, at least 100 each day on Field 2 due to close proximity to road.**
- 7) Lunch is available at local fast food facilities within 1 – 2 blocks of club. **
- 8) Preregistration is advised. Otherwise, plan on the 9:00 start time.
- 9) Current DOD COVID POLICY requires masks must be worn inside the buildings. This may be relaxed as State and CDC requirements change.
- 10) The club assumes no liability in cases of theft or injuries while on JBLM McChord Field.
- 11) *BASE PASS & PREREGISTRATION: All **non-DOD shooters and their guests** need a pass to enter JBLM McChord Field. Due to the time constraint in getting passes back and mailed, please contact Gil Hildebrand **NLT April 6, 2022**, by phone 253-468-9886 if no answer – leave message!!
