Event #2 Ironman Options (200s) \$12: 200s are 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> 100s, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> 100s, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> 100s, based on

class. High score in class wins, ties split.

To accommodate additional shooters, a 3<sup>rd</sup> rotation may be added; therefore, **PREREGISTRATION IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED!!** \* Otherwise, plan on the 9:30 start time

**Entry fee**: \$165, includes fees. \$25 of each entry returned to class. Payout: 100% 1-4 in class, 5 thru 8 in class splits 60-40, 9 or more splits 50/30/20. Champion takes class money, but no less than highest class payout, plus \$10 of each entry. All ties will be decided by Doubles at 3-4-5 total by station. Checks will be mailed. Honorary concurrents.

- 3) Shoot management reserves the right to modify the program as necessary. Changes will be posted at registration.
- 4) Please have your current, updated 2024 NSSA classification card available at nssa-nsca.org/skeet/memberlogin.
- 5) Canteberry Voice Call system may be used. Shooters may be asked to keep score.
- 6) Due to nationwide shortage, shooters must provide their own ammunition to include proof shells. PLEASE use #9 shot for all events.
- 7) Lunch will be available at local fast food facilities within 1 2 blocks of club. \*\*
- 8) The club assumes no liability in cases of theft or injuries while on JBLM McChord Field.
- \*BASE PASS & PREREGISTRATION: All non-DOD shooters and their guests need a pass to enter JBLM McChord Field.
